### Taking Care of Yourself During Pregnancy


- Yoga: Learn yoga to improve circulation and help with many discomforts associated with pregnancy, \$40
- Relaxation & Breathing: Learn relaxation and stress relief techniques, \$40

#### **Preparing for Labor & Delivery**

- Maternity Tour: Enjoy an in-person tour, including labor and delivery room or view the virtual maternity tour, www.ehristianacare.org/ wirtualmaternitytour. Free
- Parent Steps: One weeknight for three weeks. This course teaches about signs of preterm labor, induction, labor, delivery and pain management. Other topics include anesthesia, e-section, postpartum care and transition to parenthood. A tour is included. Newborn care is not included. \$100
- Labor Basics: One weeknight. This is a condensed class which includes the topics covered in Parent Steps minus postpartum care and transition to parenthood. A tour is not included. \$60
- Labor/Childbirth Condensed: Two days (Friday evening and Saturday). This course includes all the information from Parent Steps class as well as a full Newborn Class. A tour is included, \$140

#### **Caring for Your Baby**

- Newborn Steps: Great for 1st time parents, adoptive parents and also serves as a refresher for experienced parents. Covers early infant care, diapering, umbilical cord care and infant safety. \$40
- Breastfeeding Class: This class teaches the benefits of breastfeeding, how to get started, role of support people, latching and positioning. Other topics include how to tell if your baby is getting enough milk, pumping, milk storage and returning to work. This class is taught by a certified lactation consultant. One support person is encouraged to attend with Mom. \$30
- Happiest Baby on the Block: Basics of Dr. Harvey Karp's program, based on his best-selling book, with step-by-step instructions on how to soothe a fussy baby and how to help your baby sleep longer. Includes CD and DVD. \$65

- CPR for Family & Friends: Learn child and infant choking and CPR (non-certifying), \$20 per person.
- Child Safety Seat Inspection: A certified technician will show you how to properly install your child safety seat. You will then be given a chance to install it yourself and have it checked to ensure that you have understood the proper technique. Please call to schedule at least 4-6 weeks before your due date. You will need to bring your infant car seat with you. This inspection takes about 20 minutes. Call for pricing.
